



RESOLUCIÓN DE 27 DE FEBRERO DEL PRESIDENTE DEL CONSORCIO CAMPUS IBERUS POR LA QUE SE APRUEBA LA CONVOCATORIA DE BECAS PARA LA REALIZACIÓN DE MOVILIDADES DE FORMACIÓN PARA PDI / PTGAS Y ESTUDIANTES DE DOCTORADO EN EL MARCO DEL PROYECTO “MOVILIDAD ESPAÑA-ALBANIA” SUBVENCIONADO POR EL PROGRAMA ERASMUS+ KA 1

El Consorcio de Movilidad de Educación Superior formado por la Universidad de Zaragoza, la Universidad Pública de Navarra, la Universidad de Lleida y la Universidad de La Rioja y coordinado por el Consorcio Campus Iberus, acreditado ante el SEPIE con n.º 2021-1-ES01-KA130-HED-000004265, ha obtenido financiación dentro del programa Erasmus + KA171- HED: Proyectos de movilidad de estudiantes y personal de Educación Superior financiada con fondos de política exterior para su proyecto ‘Movilidad España-Albania’ para la realización de estancias de movilidad de personal y doctorandos de las universidades del consorcio y de la universidad albanesa Universiteti i Vlorës Ismail Qemali.

HE RESUELTO

Primero.- Aprobar la convocatoria de becas dentro del proyecto “*Movilidad España-Albania*” y sus bases, que se publican como Anexo I.

Contra la presente resolución que agota la vía administrativa según lo establecido en el artículo 23 de los Estatutos del Consorcio Campus Iberus, los interesados podrán interponer recurso potestativo de reposición ante el presidente del Consorcio Campus Iberus en el plazo de un mes o recurso contencioso-administrativo ante los juzgados del mismo orden de Zaragoza en el plazo de dos meses, plazos que se computarán desde el día siguiente al de su publicación en la página web del Consorcio Campus Iberus www.campusiberus.es.

STAFF AND STUDENT MOBILITY FROM PARTNER COUNTRIES

The Erasmus+ Programme of the European Commission promotes the mobility of staff. The action KA171 of this programme provides funding for exchange mobility with partner countries. Campus Iberus has been awarded with grants under the action KA171 therefore staff and PhD students from our partner universities have the opportunity to fund their mobilities.

1. Purpose of the Call

Staff and student mobility is one of the key activities within the framework of the European Commission's Erasmus+ Programme in the field of Education, Youth and Sport.

The present Call is based on the funding awarded to Campus Iberus for mobility projects with non EU- partner countries under Key Action 171 of the Erasmus+ Programme. Mobilities will be implemented from May to July 2024, always before 31st July 2024.

The main purposes of this call are:

- expose students to different views, knowledge, teaching and research methods as well as work practices in their study field in the European and international context;
- develop their transversal skills such as communication skills, language skills, critical thinking, problem solving, inter-cultural skills and research skills;
- facilitate personal development such as the ability to adapt to new situations and self-confidence.

The objective is also to enable university staff to teach abroad as part of their professional development in order to:

- share their expertise;
- experience new teaching environments;
- acquire new innovative pedagogical and curriculum design skills as well as digital skills;
- connect with their peers abroad to develop common activities to achieve the programme's objectives;
- exchange good practices and enhance cooperation between higher education institutions;
- better prepare students for the world of work

In the framework of the Erasmus+ Programme, all mobility activities are



conditional upon the signature of an interinstitutional agreement between the sending and the receiving universities before the start of the mobility.

2. Requisites for applicants and partner universities.

The partner universities will announce this call through their own web pages and will disseminate the news about this call in their university communities.

To be eligible, applicants must fulfil the following general conditions:

Mobility for staff:

- Assume responsibility for performing the mobility before 31st July 2024.
- Have a contractual relationship at the time of application and while in mobility at one of the partner universities.
- Submit a Mobility Agreement Proposal accepted by the sending and the receiving institutions, including at least 8 hours of training during the 5 working days stay (Monday- Friday).

Mobility for PhD:

- Assume responsibility for performing the mobility before 31st July 2024.
- Students must be registered in a HEI and enrolled in studies leading to a recognised degree or another recognised tertiary level qualification (up to and including the level of doctorate).

3. Total budget for this call

*Initially 2 mobility grants will be allocated for each type of stay, the modification in the number of grants will be conditioned to the request of the participants and the total budget for this call.



4. Mobility grant amount per participant

Grants consist of a travel allowance and a daily amount stated by the Erasmus+ Programme:

- For PhD Students (long duration mobility 2 to 3 months excluding travel days)

- For PhD students (short mobilities from 5 to 14 days, excluding travel days)

5. Duration

Staff mobility for training: 7 days of training plus 2 travel days.

PhD mobility for traineeship:

Short Mobilities: from 5 to 14 days, excluding travel time.

Long mobilities: from 2 to 3 months of physical mobility, excluding travel time.

6. Compatibility.

Scholarships under the Erasmus+ Partner Countries KA107 programme are not compatible with any other Erasmus+ scholarships granted for the same mobility.

7. Evaluation Criteria

The selection process will be based on the principles of equity, fairness and transparency.

The selection committee, formed by the Executive Director of Campus Iberus , an Erasmus+ project manager and an international relations technician of Campus Iberus, will evaluate the applicants based on the following criteria:

For PhD :

- Motivation Letter in English (maximum 850 words)
- CV (research experience)
- Proposed research plan
- English Language Level

For Staff:

- Motivation Letter (maximum 850 words)
- CV (research experience)
- Proposed mobility plan (template)
- English Language Proficiency

7. Application process

The application period will be open from 29th February to 22th March 2024.

Applicants must complete the online application form on the Campus Iberus website and upload the required documents in the application form.

The required documents are: application form , copy of passport or official ID document, and mobility agreement accepted by the home and receiving





institution.

8 . Call decision

The selection committee is in charge of conducting the selection process. A first decision will be published on the website and will be announced to the beneficiaries and partner universities by e-mail by the beginning of April 2024.

10. Rights of the beneficiary

- To perform the entire mobility period awarded without the possibility of extending the grant.
- To receive the grant according to the amounts set out in the Erasmus+ Programme guidelines. The expenses not covered by the scholarship will be borne by the beneficiary.
- To receive information and advice on the application procedure, as well as pre-departure and on-site guidance.

12. Obligations of the beneficiary

- To obtain, if necessary, the Visa for the stay in the receiving country
- To carry out the mobility stay according to the proposal and dates committed, always before 31st July 2024. In the event of force majeure, the mobility period must be modified by signing an addendum to the agreement.
- To complete all procedures and fill in the required documents as required by the Erasmus+ Programme, before, during and after the mobility period, meeting the deadlines determined by Campus Iberus.

i. Before mobility:

- Signature of the Grant Agreement
- Signature of the Mobility Agreement Proposal

ii. After mobility:

- Submission of the Mobility Certificate
- Online mobility final assessment survey
- Any other obligation inherent to the Erasmus+ Programme and the internal regulations of the sending and receiving institutions.
- Prove coverage of Travel Assistance and Accident Insurance including medical, surgical and hospitalization expenses and civil liability in Spain.

13. Information

14. Data protection clause
