EU4EU STAFF MOBILITY 2024 AI AND ACADEMIA: TUNING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS WITH THE PROFESSIONAL SKILLS OF THE FUTURE

SUMMARY

The fourth Staff Mobility meeting, organized by EuGen - European Generation for the EU4EU network - European Universities for the European Union and co-financed by the Erasmus+ program, will be held in Brussels from May 14 to 17, 2024, focusing on the evolution of Artificial Intelligence and its impact on the educational and work landscape.

The EU4EU network, active for a decade, continues to be a bridge between the academic and professional worlds, facilitating Erasmus+ professional internships for university students in European companies. EuGen - European Generation, creator of the EU4EU network, international coordinator and leader of the Italian EU4EU consortium, organizes the initiative with the support of the Regione Lazio office in Brussels, which will host the event, and in collaboration with the Italian-Belgian Chamber of Commerce, which will accompany the participants on the guided tour.

The event's program includes two days of exclusive training for the 46 University partners of the EU4EU network in Italy, France, Spain, and Portugal, and continues with a conference day under the theme "Al and Academia: Tuning educational programs with the professional skills of the future". The series of events will conclude with a visit to the European institutions, witnessing the commitment to a deeper understanding of European cohesion.

The conference will benefit from the presence of distinguished speakers, representatives of the academic, business, and institutional world, offering a comprehensive overview of European initiatives related to Al.

The training sessions and the conference will aim to reflect on how universities can better equip students for the evolving job market, with a particular focus on competencies related to Artificial Intelligence, in response to emerging needs in the business sector.
